at Castle Rock to be known as Harry C. Miller Post No. 1187 Department of Colorado and this instrument, unless revoked or suspended, shall be conclusive evidence of the lawful existence thereof.

By the acceptance of this Charter, the said Post acknowledges irrevocable jurisdiction and declares itself to be in all things subject to the Constitution of The American Legion and of the Department of Colorado and the rules, regulations, orders and laws promulgated in pursuance thereof; and further the said Post pledges itself, through its members, to uphold, protect and defend the Constitution of The United States and the principles of true Americanism, for the common welfare of the living and in solemn commemoration of those who died that liberty might not perish from the Earth.

In Witness Whereof, this Charter is given under the hand and seal of the National Commander, duly attested by the National Adjutant, at National Headquarters in Indianapolis, Indiana, this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1988 and countersigned by the Commander and the Adjutant for the Department of Colorado at Denver, the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1988.
